


Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 3. On-Resistance versus Gate-to-Source Voltage




Figure 4. On-Resistance versus Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 5. On-Resistance Variation with Temperature






Figure 6. Drain-to-Source Leakage Current versus Voltage




**Figure 7. Capacitance Variation**




**Figure 8. Gate-To-Source and Drain-To-Source Voltage versus Total Charge**



**Figure 9. Resistive Switching Time Variation versus Gate Resistance**




**Figure 10. Diode Forward Voltage versus Current**
