

Gate Current vs. Gate-Source Voltage



#### Capacitance vs. Drain-to-Source Voltage

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
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


**On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature** 




**On-Resistance vs. Gate-to-Source Voltage**



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




Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient






